Hurricane + Tornado Response & Recovery

AT&T FirstNet deployed a large fleet of CRDs for FirstNet in Clarksville, TN as they worked to support the tornado devastated areas. The Compact Rapid Deployables supported hospitals, PSAPs, critical facilities, ICPs and other FirstNet and Emergency Response needs.


Event Management

At the beginning of 2022, multiple CRDs for FirstNet were deployed at the King of the Hammers 100,000+ person off-road event, where each CRD provided over 12 square miles of FirstNet coverage. Rescue 42 worked with the Bureau of Land Management team to provide FirstNet connectivity to the first responders responsible for keeping everyone safe at the event.



Hurricane Response

At New Orleans City Hall, the CRD for FirstNet supplied cellular and internet service so NOLA city management could continue to work from their offices during Hurricane Ida.



Wildland Fire Response

The CRD for FirstNet traveled 800 miles through a snowstorm to get to the heart of the Colorado fire zone, where it supported emergency response teams working where cell phone service had burned out.


Emergency Response

"It's been a challenge for us to stay connected to our emergency response teams across the state during the last few fire seasons... The coverage that FirstNet and the CRD device will provide will allow us to be flexible during our response to disasters and bring coverage to first responders onsite at the scene."



Wildland Fire Response

The fast-growing Dixie Fire was supported by a CRD for FirstNet after a critical cell tower went down in the summer of 2021. Firefighters were able to utilize internet and cell phone service once the deployable was sent to the remote location, at the center of the fire.



CAL FIRE deployed their Cell-On-Wheels unit at the 2021 Dixie Fire in Northern California.

The 12 CRDs Nevada Energy deployed not only assisted their crews during the massive 2021 Tamarack Fire, but also supported other FirstNet first responders in the area.

Event Management

The CRD for FirstNet supported the Chicago Police Department and Superior Air-Ground Ambulance Service during the 2021 Chicago Marathon.



The 2021 NFL draft was supported with the CRD for FirstNet.



CRD for FirstNet supported critical communications in the case of an incident at the Formula 1 Grand Prix in Miami in Spring 2022.

Rescue 42 visited the Missoula Technology and Development Center to demonstrate and train the MTDC on how to deploy and use their first CRD for FirstNet for forest fires. As you can see, the U.S. Forest Service pick-up trucks had no problem delivering high speed internet and FirstNet cellular communications capabilities directly to the scene.



Wildland Fire Response

The Nevada Energy Fire Mitigation team deployed multiple CRDs for FirstNet at the Caldor Fire in South Lake Tahoe. Their logistics efforts brought back valuable communication resources.

The Marshall Fire tore through Boulder County in the final days of 2021, resulting in damaged infrastructure and congested commercial networks. The CRD for FirstNet was operational in less than one hour after arriving on site, making coverage available for public safety and enabling first responders to focus on the fire. One week after the fire, the CRD was used again to support coordination and planning for a presidential visit.




Business Continuity
